ALLEGHENY VALLEY REGIONAL POLICE COMMISSION MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department Board of Commissioners was called to order at 4:38 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Stoneburner at the Springdale Township Municipal Building located at 100 Plate Drive, Harwick, Pennsylvania followed by the pledge of allegiance.

Prior to the meeting, the Board recognized the teacher and the students of the Northern Westmoreland Career and Technology Center with a plaque for the refurbishment of the of the Allegheny Valley Regional Mobile Command Unit. A staff member from Representative Mandy Steele's office presented the students with citations from the Pennsylvania House of Representative.

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT:

The Chief read the monthly report for June 2024. A total of 189 events: 6 Incidents, 5 Arrests, 5 Adult, 0 Juvenile, 6 Traffic Collisions, 16 Citations and 38 EMS. The Chief noted that the community events, Strawberry Festival and Cheswick parade were successful. Traffic control for the Iron City concerts went well.

The new 2024 Ford Explorer will be in service sometime during the week of July 15th. The Chief discussed the mileage and condition of the vehicles and recommended that vehicle #07 be sold.

GENERAL OFFICE:

1. Motion by Commissioner Igo to approve the meeting minutes from the June 11, 2024 regular monthly meeting, 2nd by Commissioner Kuhns. Motion passed unanimously.

BUDGET & FINANCE:

1. Motion by Commissioner Taliani to approve the bill list as provided for July 2024, 2nd by Commissioner Igo. Motion passed unanimously.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE:

1. Motion by Commissioner Kuhns to authorize the Chief of Police to advertise the sale of a police vehicle on Municibid, 2nd by Commissioner Igo. Discussion followed with Chief advising that the vehicle will be stripped of lettering and lights removed. The decision upon Chief's recommendation, will be to sell the 2016 Ford Explorer. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Taliani complimented AVRPD on how quickly the parking lots were cleared following the Jimmy Buffet concert.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Carroll asked about how resident's complaints should be handled by the Board. It was noted by Commissioner Igo and Kuhns that there was a discussion at January meeting. A commissioner from the resident's municipality should speak to the resident.

Commissioner Yaksich talked about the need for residents to contact 911 upon witnessing anything suspicious.

3 new applications were received for part-time officer positions and arrangements to be made with civil service for testing.
