CITIZEN'S COMMENTS:

Connie Jerich of Jerich Insurance provided the 2024/2025 Worker's Compensation Insurance quote in the amount of \$19,023 noting that the experience modification rate decreased for the upcoming year.

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT:

The Chief's month report was read for the month of May 2024. A total of 208 Events: 5 Incidents, 10 Arrests, 10 Adult, 0 Juvenile, 11 Traffic Collisions, 17 Citations, 40 EMS. On May 15, 2024, an audit was conducted regarding PCCD Compliance Monitoring for Juveniles consistent with federal requirements.
