

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT:

The Chief read the monthly report for the month of November 2024. A total of 159 Events: 104 Incidents, 3 Arrests, 3 Adult, 0 Juvenile, 7 Traffic Collisions, 25 Citations, 55 EMS. Discussion regarding a 2025 vehicle that was budgeted. The Chief would like to wait until after the winter months before purchasing.

3. Discussion regarding holiday gift cards for employees. Motion by Commissioner Yaksich to approve the purchase of \$50.00 gift cards from Sheetz for each employee of AVRPD, 2nd by Commissioner Kuhns. Motion passed unanimously.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE:

1. Discussion with the Chief regarding the benefits of the 1033 Program for 2025. Motion by Commissioner Kuhns to continue the 1033 Program in 2025, 2nd by Commissioner Igo. Motion passed unanimously.
