### CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT:

Chief read the report for the month of August 2025. August report: 163 Events, 89 Incidents, 4 Arrest, 4 Adult, 0 Juvenile, 6 Traffic Collisions, 11 Citations, 39 EMS.

### GENERAL OFFICE:

1. Motion by Commissioner Igo to accept the minutes from the regular monthly meeting of the Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department Board of Commissioners of August 12, 2025, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Taliani. Motion passed unanimously.

### BUDGET & FINANCE:

3. Motion by Commissioner Igo to approve the Cost Study for the DROP through PMRS, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Schwartz. Discussion regarding the process of DROP for a retiree. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Motion by Commissioner Yaksich to approve the 2026 Allegheny Valley Regional Police Department Budget, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Igo. Discussion regarding the budget. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Motion by Commissioner Taliani to approve the new employee agreement effective January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2030, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Igo. Motion passed unanimously.

**POLICE OPERATIONS:**

1. Motion by Commissioner Yaksich to purchase a new police vehicle in the fourth quarter of 2025, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Igo. Discussion regarding the approximate cost of \$65,000 for vehicle and upfitting, leasing with 6 payments, 3-year term, options for financing, payments included in 2025 and 2026 budgets. Motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Chief discussed the success of the car show at Iron City Brewery.
2. Chief advised that there were no issues or complaints for the first football games at the new field.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Audit for police department will begin following the municipal audits.
2. Commissioner Yaksich advised that an email was sent to the Solicitor of Springdale Borough, with the approval from Solicitor Shaw, stating that any time that a meeting is scheduled with AVRPD, the secretary is to be contacted to make arrangements for an AVRPD board member to be present.
